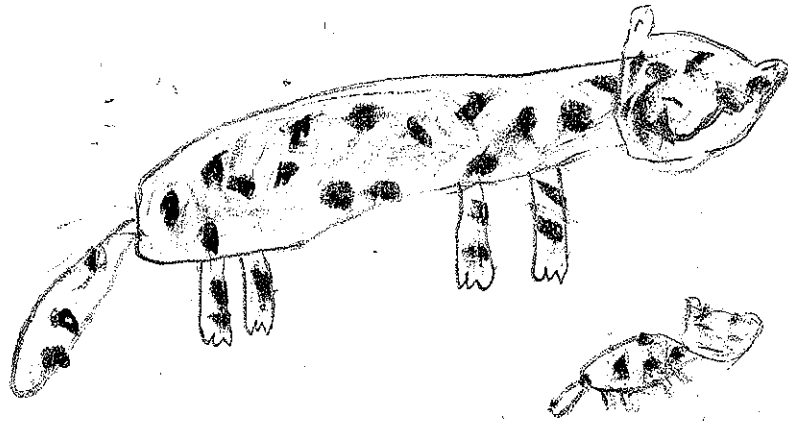


Cheetahs can even climb trees.



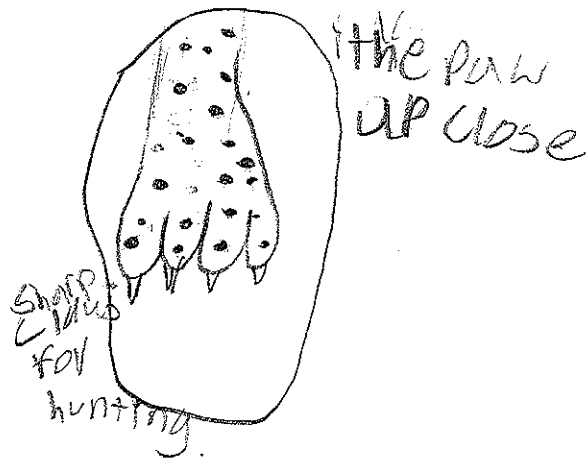
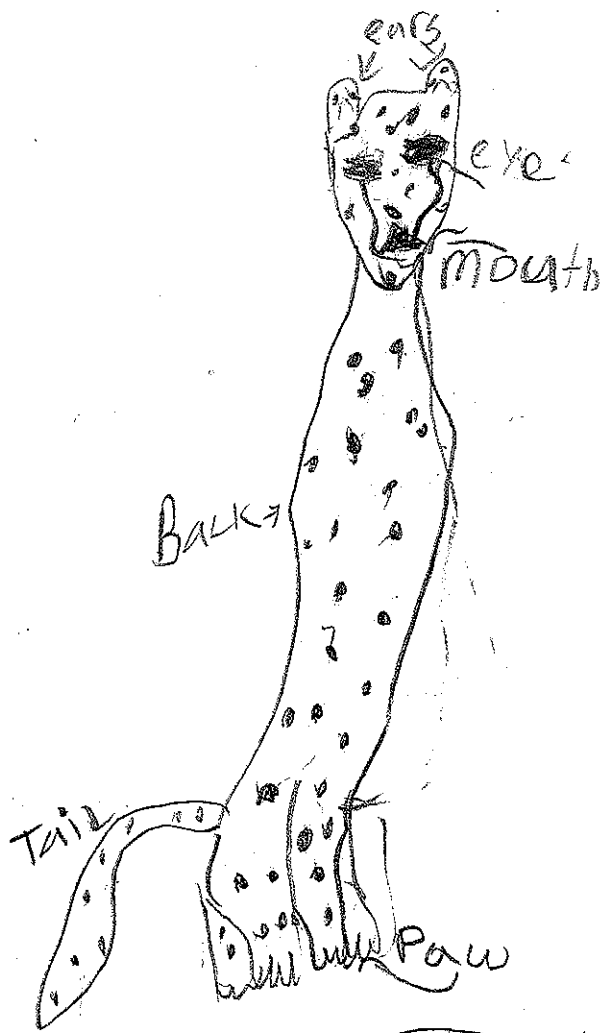
